### SITUATIONAL AWARENESS

- I. Collect available data about the patient;
- II. Collect data from the team to identify problems;
- III. More frequently re-assess when patient's condition deteriorate;
- IV. Inform your team about seriousness of the situation;
- V. Prevent or minimize potential problems by thinking ahead;

### TEAM WORK

- I. Based on information received create with your team a plan for treatment;
- II. Work together with your team to achieve set up goals;
- III. Inform about changes in an action plan;
- IV. Make sure that everyone has a required information about the patient's condition;
- V. Make sure everyone remain calm and control situation.

### COMMUNICATION

- I. Use names and non-verbal signals;
- II. Use close loop communication;
- III. Avoid disrupting factors (i.e. few people taking at the same time);
- IV. Make sure everyone can share their ideas;
- V. Use clear language (short and simple commands).

### DECISION MAKING

- I. Systematically analyse information, regarding possible actions;
- II. When analysing data, always take into consideration patient's condition;
- III. Use pauses to make group decisions;
- IV. Ask for suggestions in problematic situation;
- V. Repeat assessment after intervention or treatment.

### RESOURCES

- I. Check equipment;
- II. Give tasks according to competences;
- III. Do not overload single team members;
- IV. Identify situations with lack of resources;
- V. Call for help early, if there's a needed.

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
